TIP OF THE MONTH

Making More Short Putts

Making short putts are a key component of scoring well in a round of golf. You cannot afford to miss the opportunity of these putts. Implementing golf putting tips to increase your consistency on short putts can really help you shave strokes off your rounds.

Consider these two golf putting tips to help you make more short putts:

1. The putterface is crucial to making short putts. You need to square your putterface. A problem many golfers has with short putts is not being able to keep the putterface square throughout the stroke. You need to be sure to keep it square by using your shoulders to control the stroke and not your hands. Your hands should stay still throughout the stroke, while only your shoulders move through the putt.
2. Focus on your routine. Many short putts are missed because golfers allow the thought of missing a short putt to dominate the thoughts inside their head. By focusing on your routine. You will be better able to eliminate or quiet these negative thoughts.

Sure, these, two golf putting tips are very simple. But so are short putts. All it really take to make more short putts is to follow these two tips.
